

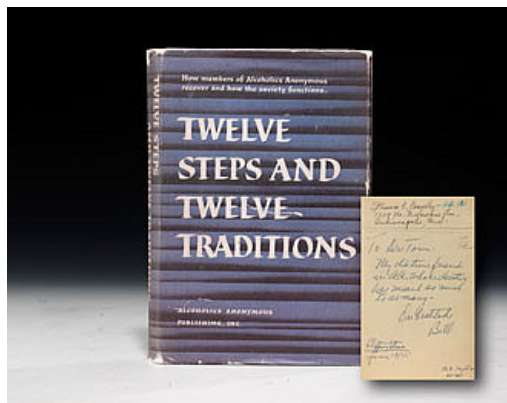

Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions 1953 First Edition

The first printing was April of 1953; second, November of 1956; third, December of 1958. The 1st edition was printed in conjunction with the first Harpers & Brothers printing. AA copies were distributed by direct sale to AA members (Alcoholics Anonymous Publishing Inc.) while the Harper's edition was for distribution to bookstores. Both copies sold for \$2.75 but copies of the book were offered to AA groups at a 50¢ discount so that they could make some money on resale to their members.

In this book, Wilson expands & updates the program of recovery published in the Big Book based on his 14 years of additional experience with sobriety. Here is where Wilson first published in book form the Twelve Traditions, the brilliant foundational rules of AA that had been approved in 1950 by the Cleveland Convention of AA.
