With 300 days of sunshine a year, San Antonio is a warm destination year round. On average, July is the warmest month, with average highs around 96° degrees Fahrenheit and evening lows around 74° Fahrenheit. A.A. will be making its best effort to provide plenty of shade and water for attendees. As hot as it is outdoors, be prepared for cool temperatures indoors—the air conditioning will be on!

A.A. is truly international, and meetings in languages including American Sign Language (ASL), French, Japanese, Spanish, and more, will be available Friday and Saturday. Additionally, the Big Meetings in the Alamodome will be simultaneously interpreted into several languages based on need and cost. GROUND TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN AIRPORT AND HOTEL

The San Antonio International Airport (SAT) is approximately 10 miles from downtown.

Shuttle: There is a shared ride shuttle service at the airport. Charges: \$18.00 ticket per person to downtown hotels or \$32.00 for a round trip ticket. Service to other areas charged by zone. Major credit cards are accepted. To make reservations call: (210)281-9900. For more information visit www.sairportshuttle.com. Make reservations online, and save an additional \$2.

Taxi: Taxi cabs are available curbside outside of baggage claim at Terminals 1 & 2. If you need assistance, please contact an Airport Ground Transportation Agent wearing an airport badge. Fares to San Antonio downtown areas are approximately \$25.00 (U.S.) per taxicab. (2 – 6 people may share a cab at no extra cost!)

GETTING AROUND IN SAN ANTONIO

Many hotels in this Downtown Core are within a walking distance of the Convention Center. In order to keep the registration fee affordable, no door-to-door shuttle bus service will be available in the Downtown Core. There will be identified stops for a downtown loop shuttle for those needing transportation. A limited-schedule bus shuttle will run between the Convention Center/Stadium area and hotels and motels outside the Downtown Core of hotels, e.g., airport hotels.

International checks and money orders (except Canadian) must be in U.S. funds drawn on a U.S. bank. NOTE: We cannot accept travel agency checks for multiple registrations.

Once registered, your confirmation will be emailed to you, along with a link to the Housing Reservation Web site. If your preferred method of communication is mail, please allow one to two weeks to receive your registration confirmation and housing packet in the mail.

On-site fees will apply to registrations postmarked or received after May 14; forms received after that date may not be processed, so plan to register on-site at the Convention Center (Preregister to avoid waiting in long lines). The on-site registration fee is \$110 USD.

If you register by the May 14, 2010 deadline, your badge(s) will be mailed to you. Bring your badge with you to San Antonio; it is your proof of registration! When you arrive in San Antonio, come to the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center to pick up your badge holder and Convention Program. The Registration Hall opens Wednesday morning.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

All cancellations must be made in writing. Refunds will be made only upon receipt of your written request enclosing your badge(s), and if received by **May 14, 2010**. No exceptions. There is a \$5 USD or \$7 CAD administrative processing fee for cancellations which will be deducted from the refund. Allow 6 weeks for processing. Written requests and badges should be mailed to:

HOUSING INFORMATION

Housing reservation information, including the Housing Bureau's contact information, will be included with your registration confirmation. Because of the number of hotel rooms available in San Antonio, housing for the 2010 International Convention will be on a first-come, first-served basis. However you must be registered for the Convention before you may make your reservations. Once we have received your registration form and payment, you will receive housing information by the same method you sent in your registration. If online, a link to the Housing Reservation Website will be sent to your e-mail address along with your registration confirmation. You will then be able to complete your hotel reservation online.

If you register by mail or fax, housing information will be sent to you by postal mail. Complete your housing and deposit information and send it to the address indicated on the Housing Reservation Form. Your hotel reservation will be processed and a confirmation mailed to you.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

1. Registration payment must accompany all mailed or faxed registration forms.
2. Mailed pre-registration forms must be postmarked, and faxed forms must be received, by May 14, 2010. After that date, the on-site rate of \$110 USD will be charged.
3. Any changes to registration information already processed must be made in writing before May 14, 2010, or onsite. All changes must be made by the current registrant on file. No charges will be assessed for corrections to badge information excluding Substitutions (see below).
4. Substitutions made on or before May 14, 2010 will be subject to a \$5 USD / \$7 CAD processing fee.
5. Substitutions after May 14, 2010 must be made on site and will be subject to a \$15 USD processing fee. Note: You must have the original attendee's badge to make on site substitutions.
6. Replacement of lost or forgotten badges will be subject to a \$15 USD reprint fee. Your badge will be mailed to you. Remember to bring it with you to San Antonio.
